UPDATE BY DR. KALUMBI SHANGULA, MINISTER OF HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES ON COVID-19 IN NAMIBIA.

01 May 2021

WINDHOEK

1. We announce two hundred and forty-eight (248) new COVID-19 confirmed cases identified from one thousand eight hundred and forty-nine (1 849) results received from the laboratories in the last twenty-four (24) hours, which represents 13% positivity ratio. The gender distribution of the reported cases is one hundred and twenty-four (124) for both male and females. The age ranges from three (3) months to eighty-four (84) years. The new COVID-19 cases are geographically distributed as follows:

2. Today we recorded new cases from all fourteen (14) regions. Among the confirmed cases are fifty-two (52) learners of which 16 are from Rehoboth High School and Niilo Taapopi Senior Secondary School respectively, and the rest are from different schools. Eleven (11) health care workers and ten (10) teachers tested positive for COVID-19.

3. One hundred and eighty-three (183) recoveries were recorded from the following regions:
