

UPDATE BY DR. KALUMBI SHANGULA, MINISTER OF HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES ON COVID-19 IN NAMIBIA.

02 December 2020

WINDHOEK *Check against Delivery 1. Good afternoon fellow Namibians. Today, sixty-one (61) new COVID-19 confirmed cases were identified from one thousand four hundred and sixty-six (1466) results received from the laboratories. This number represents a 4% positivity ratio. The gender distribution of the reported cases is thirty-one (31) males and thirty (30) females. The age range is from two (2) years to sixty-two (62) years. The new COVID-19 cases are distributed as follows:

- 2. Among the 61 confirmed cases, seventeen (17) are learners and two (2) healthcare workers sporadically distributed within regions. Cases reported from Lüderitz district, include nine (9) employees from the fishing industry in Lüderitz.
- 3. Today we are reporting ninety-seven (97) new recoveries, with Oshana region reporting the highest number of recoveries. This brings the total number of recoveries to 13 697.
