UPDATE BY DR. KALUMBI SHANGULA, MINISTER OF HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES ON COVID-19 IN NAMIBIA.

04 August 2021 WINDHOEK

1. We announce two hundred and thirty-seven (237) new COVID-19 confirmed cases from one thousand and nine hundred and twenty-one (1 921) results in the last twenty-four (24) hours reporting cycle, which represents 12% positivity ratio. The gender distribution is one hundred and thirty- six (136) females and one hundred and one (101) males. The age ranges from seven (7) months to ninety-five (95) years. The cases are shown in Table 1.

- 2. We are reporting cases from thirteen (13) regions, with an exception of Omaheke region. Oshana and Zambezi regions reporting the highest number of cases, accounting for about 18% of all the confirmed cases each, followed by Khomas region with 15%. Among the confirmed cases are thirty (30) learners, four (4) teachers, five (5) students and three (3) health care workers.
- 3. Of all the confirmed cases, two (2) are reported to have received only one dose of the COVID-19 vaccine.
- 4. We have recorded three hundred and twenty-three (323) new recoveries.

5. We now have twenty thousand one hundred and seventy-seven (20 177) active cases. Three hundred and seventy-five (375) are hospitalized, of which seventy-two (72) are in Intensive Care Unit (ICU).

- 7. Outapi district reported the highest number of deaths with eight (8) deaths, followed by Opuwo district with five (5) deaths, Okahao district with four (4) deaths, Oshakati district with three (3) deaths, Windhoek, Swakopmund, and Katima Mulilo districts with two (2) deaths each, and Okahandja, Walvis Bay, Otjiwarongo, Engela, and Omusati districts with one (1) death each.
- 8. Of the reported deaths, one (1) occurred at home and one (1) was declared dead on arrival at health facility.
- 9. One death case from Swakopmund had received one dose of AstraZeneca vaccine.
- 10. Of the reported deaths, seven (7) occurred between 17-24 July 2021, nine (9) occurred between 25-31 July 2021, and fourteen (14) occurred between 01-04 August 2021, of which seven (7) deaths occurred on the 03 August 2021, that is within twenty four hours reporting cycle.
- 11. As of today, a total of **169 790** people had received at least one dose of the COVID-19 vaccine, while **51 138** had received two doses and regarded as fully vaccinated, as depicted in table 5 and 6 below:
