UPDATE BY DR. KALUMBI SHANGULA, MINISTER OF HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES ON COVID-19 IN NAMIBIA.

5 March 2021 WINDHOEK

1. We announce two hundred and ten (210) new COVID-19 confirmed cases identified from one thousand four hundred and thirty-eight (1 438) results received from the laboratories in the last twenty-four (24) hours, which represents 15% positivity ratio. The gender distribution of the reported cases is one hundred and seven (107) females and one hundred and three (103) males. The age range is from four (4) months to eighty-five (85) years. The new COVID-19 cases are geographically distributed as follows:

- 2. Eighty-eight (88) of the confirmed cases are learners. Forty-nine (49) are from Okahandja Senior Secondary School (SSS) in Okahandja district, eleven (11) from Ohandungu SSS in Opuwo district and the rest are from different schools. Eight (8) teachers and nine (9) healthcare workers also tested positive to coronavirus infection.
- **3.** We have recorded two hundred and sixteen (216) new recoveries and the recovery rate for Namibia stands at 94%.

4. The total number of active cases currently stands at one thousand nine hundred and seventy-two (1 972). One hundred and fifty-one (151) are hospitalized, of which twenty-one (21) are in ICUs.
