

UPDATE BY DR. KALUMBI SHANGULA, MINISTER OF HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES ON COVID-19 IN NAMIBIA.

5 May 2021

**WINDHOEK** \*Check against Delivery 1. We announce one hundred and twenty (120) new COVID-19 confirmed cases identified from one thousand two hundred and seventy-five (1 275) results received from the laboratories in the last twenty-four (24) hours, which represents 9% positivity ratio. The gender distribution of the reported cases is seventy-two (72) females and forty-eight (48) males. The age ranges from eight (8) months to eighty-five (85) years. The new COVID-19 cases are geographically distributed as follows:
