UPDATE BY DR. KALUMBI SHANGULA, MINISTER OF HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES ON COVID-19 IN NAMIBIA.

06 August 2021 WINDHOEK

1. We announce three hundred and nineteen (319) new COVID-19 confirmed cases from one thousand seven hundred and thirty-three (1 733) results in the last twenty-four (24) hours reporting cycle, which represents 18% positivity ratio. The gender distribution is one hundred and seventy-two (172) females and one hundred and forty-seven (147) males. The age ranges from three (3) days to one hundred and eleven (111) years. The new COVID-19 cases are geographically distributed as follows:

- 2. We are reporting cases from all regions. Oshana region reporting the highest number of cases, accounting for about 16% of all the confirmed cases, followed by Khomas region with 15% and Erongo region with 14%. Among the confirmed cases are thirty-four (34) learners, ten (10) teachers, eight (8) students and eight (8) health care workers.
- 3. Of all the confirmed cases, five (5) are reported to have received only one dose of the COVID-19 vaccines. None of the reported cases have received two doses of the COVID-19 vaccines.
- 4. We have recorded six hundred and seventy-seven (677) new recoveries.

5. We now have eighteen thousand five hundred and sixty-six (18 566) active cases. Three hundred and seventy-one (371) are hospitalized, of which seventy-three (73) are in Intensive Care Unit (ICU).

- 7. Oshakati and Katima Mulilo districts reported the highest number of deaths with five (5) deaths each, followed by Windhoek, Oshikuku and Engela districts with three (3) deaths each. Swakopmund, Tsumeb, Keetmanshoop, Otjiwarongo and Tsandi districts reported one (1) death each.
- 8. Of the reported deaths, four (4) occurred at home: three (3) from Katima Mulilo district and one (1) from Engela district.
- 9. None of the reported death cases were known to be vaccinated.
- 10. Of the reported deaths, seven (7) occurred between 23-31 July 2021, thirteen (13) occurred between 02-04 August 2021, and four (4) occurred between 05-06 August 2021, the last twenty-four hours reporting cycle.
- 11. By the 6th August 2021, a total of **173 428** people had received at least one dose of the COVID-19 vaccine, while **52 681** had received two doses, as depicted in table 5 and 6 below:

• The Ministry of Health and Social Services wishes to inform members of the public that the Government of the Republic of Namibia will receive 75 000 doses of the

- AstraZenecca vaccine on Sunday, 8 August 2021. The vaccine has been donated by the Dutch Government (The Netherlands).
- Preference will be given to those who have received the first dose of AstraZeneca already. The Ministry is therefore calling upon those members of the public who have been waiting to receive their second dose of AstraZenecca to go to the nearest vaccination sites on Tuesday, 10 August 2021.
- We are expecting more doses of AstraZeneca during the course of this months. We will also add more vaccine types in our arsenal to give the public more choices.
