7 April 2021 WINDHOEK

1. We announce thirty-one (31) new COVID-19 confirmed cases identified from seven hundred and fifty-two (752) results received from the laboratories in the last twenty-four (24) hours, which represents 4% positivity ratio. The gender distribution of the reported cases is seventeen (17) males and fourteen (14) females. The age range is from (9) months to fifty-six (56) years. The new COVID-19 cases are geographically distributed as follows:

- 2. Today we record cases from four (4) regions. Among the confirmed cases are three (3) learners and three (3) health care workers from different schools and different health facilities respectively.
- **3.** We have recorded six hundred and sixty-five (665) new recoveries.

4. The total number of active cases currently stands at one thousand one hundred and seventy-five (1 175). Of these, one hundred and forty-seven (147) are hospitalized, of which thirty-two (32) are in critical care (ICUs). Twelve (12) regions have hospitalized patients due to COVID-19, except Kavango West and East.
