UPDATE BY DR. KALUMBI SHANGULA, MINISTER OF HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES ON COVID-19 IN NAMIBIA.

7 May 2021

WINDHOEK

1. We announce ninety-two (92) new COVID-19 confirmed cases identified from one thousand two hundred and sixty-seven (1 267) results received from the laboratories in the last twenty-four (24) hours, which represents 7% positivity ratio. The gender distribution of the reported cases is forty-seven (47) females and forty-five (45) males. The age ranges from two (2) years to ninety-four (94) years. The new COVID-19 cases are geographically distributed as follows:
