UPDATE BY DR. KALUMBI SHANGULA, MINISTER OF HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES ON COVID-19 IN NAMIBIA.

07 August 2021 WINDHOEK

1. We announce two hundred and twenty-nine (229) new COVID-19 confirmed cases from one thousand seven hundred and sixty-six (1766) results in the last twenty-four (24) hours reporting cycle, which represents 13% positivity ratio. The gender distribution is one hundred and thirty-seven (137) females and ninety-two (92) males. The age ranges from six (6) months to ninety-five (95) years. The new COVID-19 cases are geographically distributed as follows:

2. We are reporting cases from thirteen (13) regions, with an excemption of Kavango West region. Ohangwena region reported the highest number of cases, accounting for about

24% of all the confirmed cases, followed by Oshikoto region with 23%. Among the confirmed cases are thirty-six (36) learners, twelve (12) teachers, three (3) students and eight (8) health care workers.

- 3. Of all the confirmed cases, twenty-two (22), representing 10%, are reported to have received at least one dose of the COVID-19 vaccine, of which six (6) have received two doses of the vaccine and considered fully vaccinated.
- 4. We have observed a shift in number of confirmed cases from Khomas region to other regions especially northern regions.
- 5. We have recorded one hundred and thirty-six (136) new recoveries.

6. We now have eighteen thousand six hundred and fifty (18 650) active cases. Three hundred and seventy-two (372) are hospitalized, of which seventy-six (76) are in Intensive Care Unit (ICU). We have noted a reduction in number of admissions during these two weeks.

- 8. Mariental district reported three (3) deaths, followed by Okahao and Gobabis districts with two (2) deaths each, and Tsandi and Okahandja districts with one (1) death each. All of the reported deaths occurred in health care facilities, and none of them was vaccinated.
- 9. Of the reported deaths, one (1) occurred on 27 June 2021. Three (3) deaths occurred between 01-21 July, and five (5) occurred between 03-04 August. No reported deaths occurred within the last 24 hours reporting cycle.
- 10. By the 7 August 2021, a total of **174 896** people had received at least one dose of the COVID-19 vaccine, while **53 455** had received two doses, as depicted in tables 5 and 6 below:

## 12. Key Message

- On Sunday the 8<sup>th</sup> of August 2021, we have received 75 000 doese of AstraZeneca which had been out of stock for some weeks. We will be prioritizing those receiving the second dose. All districts are expected to have their vaccines and ready to resume vaccination with AstraZeneca on Tuesday morning the 10 August 2021.
- We therefore urge people who have been waiting for their AstraZeneca to go and receive their second doses at nearest health facilities or at vaccination sites as communicated by the district teams. We have established more vaccination sites in order to avoid long queues.
