## UPDATE BY DR. KALUMBI SHANGULA, MINISTER OF HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES ON COVID-19 IN NAMIBIA.

08 August 2021

**WINDHOEK** \*Check against Delivery We announce one hundred and sixty (160) new COVID-19 confirmed cases from one thousand four hundred and six (1 406) results in the last twenty-four (24) hours reporting cycle, which represents 11% positivity ratio. The gender distribution is ninety-four (94) females and sixty-six (66) males. The age ranges from four (4) years to one hundred and eleven (111) years. The new COVID-19 cases are geographically distributed as follows:

- 2. We are reporting cases from all fourteen regions. Erongo region reported the highest number of cases, accounting for about 26% of all the confirmed cases, followed by Otjozondjupa region with 18%. Among the confirmed cases are twenty-eight (28) learners, five (5) teachers, three (3) students and four (4) health care workers.
- 3. Of all the confirmed cases, four (4), representing 3%, are reported to have received at least one dose of the COVID-19 vaccine, of which one (1) has received two doses of the vaccine and considered fully vaccinated.
- 4. We have recorded two hundred and forty-seven (247) new recoveries.

5. We now have eighteen thousand five hundred and fifty-eight (18 558) active cases. Three hundred and sixty-eight (368) are hospitalized, of which seventy-six (76) are in ICU. We have noted a reduction in number of admissions during these two weeks.

- 7. Gobabis district reported three (3) deaths, while Windhoek and Luderitz districts reported one (1) death each. All the reported deaths occurred in health facilities. One (1) deceased case from Windhoek had received the 1<sup>st</sup> dose of AstraZeneca on 08 July, 2021. Of the reported deaths, three (3) occurred between 24-26 July, one (1) occurred on 01 August and one (1) occurred on 07 August.
- 8. As of today, a total of **175 077** people had received at least one dose of the COVID-19 vaccine, while **53 471** had received two doses, as depicted in tables 5 and 6 below:
