

UPDATE BY DR. KALUMBI SHANGULA, MINISTER OF HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES ON COVID-19 IN NAMIBIA.

08 May 2021

WINDHOEK *Check against Delivery 1. We announce three hundred and forty-one (341) new COVID-19 confirmed cases from two thousand two hundred and ninety-nine (2 299) results in the last twenty-four (24) hours, which represents 15% positivity ratio. The gender distribution is one hundred and seventy-two (172) females and one hundred and sixty-nine (169) males. The age ranges from eight (8) months to eighty-seven (87) years. The new COVID-19 cases are geographically distributed as follows:

- 2. Today we record new cases from thirteen (13) regions with Khomas and Erongo recording the highest number. Among the confirmed cases are thirty-six (36) learners of whom eight are from Eenhana Primary School and the rest are from different schools. Thirteen (13) students, seven (7) teachers, twenty (20) health care workers, three (3) inmates from Gobabis holding cells, fifteen (15) employees from the fishing industry and three (3) employees from the mining industry also tested positive to COVID-19 infection.
- 3. We have recorded twenty-seven (27) recoveries, twenty-four (24) from Hardap region and three (3) from Omaheke region.

4. We now have two thousand and twenty-six (2 026) active cases. One hundred and seventy-nine (179) are hospitalized, of which forty-five (45) are in ICUs.

- 6. Tables 3 and 4 below shows the number of people vaccinated as per reports received. All regions are continuing with the vaccination, however some reports for yesterday vaccines are yet to be received and therefore not yet included in this update.
