UPDATE BY DR. KALUMBI SHANGULA, MINISTER OF HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES ON COVID-19 IN NAMIBIA.

9 April 2021 WINDHOEK

1. We announce one hundred and thirty-nine (139) new COVID-19 confirmed cases identified from one thousand eight hundred and forty-one (1 841) results received from the laboratories in the last twenty-four (24) hours, which represents 8% positivity ratio. The gender distribution of the reported cases is seventy-eight (78) females and sixty-one (61) males. The age range is from four (4) years to ninety (90) years. The new COVID-19 cases are geographically distributed as follows:
