
## **REPUBLIC OF NAMIBIA**

UPDATE BY DR. KALUMBI SHANGULA, MINISTER OF HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES ON COVID-19 IN NAMIBIA.

10 April 2021

WINDHOEK

1. We announce one hundred and thirty (130) new COVID-19 confirmed cases from one thousand five hundred and ninety-three (1 593) results in the last twenty-four (24) hours, which represents 8% positivity ratio. The gender distribution is seventy-one (71) females and fifty-nine (59) males. The age range is from three (3) months to eighty-two (82) years. The new COVID-19 cases are geographically distributed as follows:

- 2. Today we record cases from twelve (12) regions. Among the confirmed cases are thirty-two (32) learners from different schools. Six (6) teachers and three (3) health care workers also tested positive to COVID-19.
- **3.** We have recorded seventy-two (72) new recoveries.
