UPDATE BY DR. KALUMBI SHANGULA, MINISTER OF HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES ON COVID-19 IN NAMIBIA.

11 June 2021

1. We announce one thousand four hundred and thirty-two (1 432) new COVID-19 confirmed cases from four thousand two hundred and eleven (4 211) results in the last twenty-four (24) hours, which represents 34% positivity ratio. The gender distribution is eight hundred and twenty (820) females and six hundred and twelve (612) males. The age range is from twenty (20) days to ninety-four (94) years. The new COVID-19 cases are geographically distributed as follows:
