UPDATE BY DR. KALUMBI SHANGULA, MINISTER OF HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES ON COVID-19 IN NAMIBIA.

12 September 2021

**WINDHOEK** \*Check against Delivery We announce fifty-one (51) new COVID-19 confirmed cases from nine hundred and ninety-six (996) results in the last twenty-four (24) hours reporting cycle, which represents 5.1% positivity ratio. The sex distribution is thirty (30) females and twenty-one (21) males. The age range is from one (1) year to ninety-three (93) years. The new COVID-19 cases are geographically distributed as follows:

- 2. Of the confirmed cases, twenty (20) are learners, with six (6) from Orumana Primary School and five (5) from Kaoko-tavi combined school from Opuwo district while the rest are from different schools. Six (6) teachers and one (1) student are also among the confirmed cases.
- 3. Only two (2) of the confirmed cases, have received one doses and one (1) has received two doses of the COVID-19 vaccine.
- 4. We have recorded forty-three (43) new recoveries from the following regions:
