1. We announce seven hundred and twenty-six (726) new COVID-19 confirmed cases from one thousand five hundred and ninety-four (1 594) results in the last twenty-four (24) hours, which represents 46% positivity ratio. The gender distribution is four hundred and twenty-four (424) females and three hundred and two (302) males. The age range is from twenty (28) days to eighty-four (84) years. The new COVID-19 cases are geographically distributed as follows:

4. We now have nine thousand six hundred and nine (9 609) active cases. Three hundred and seventy-seven (377) are hospitalized, of which seventy-two (72) are in Intensive Care Units (ICUs) and twenty-five (25) are in high care.
