UPDATE BY DR. KALUMBI SHANGULA, MINISTER OF HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES ON COVID-19 IN NAMIBIA.

14 July 2021 WINDHOEK

1. We announce five hundred and seventy-one (571) new COVID-19 confirmed cases from two thousand three hundred and eighty-four (2 384) results in the last twenty-four (24) hours, which represents 24% positivity ratio. The gender distribution is two hundred and ninety-five (295) males and two hundred and seventy-six (276) males. The age range is from three (3) days to one hundred and eight (108) years. The new COVID-19 cases are geographically distributed as follows:

2. We are reporting cases from (11) regions, with Khomas region reporting the highest number of cases accounting for 32% of the confirmed cases followed by ||Kharas and Otjozondjupa regions with 15% each. Among the confirmed cases are thirty-two (32) learners, four (4) teachers and six (6) students from different institutions. We are also reporting seven (7) health care workers from different health care facilities. Of all confirmed cases, seventeen (17), which translate in three (3%) percent are reported to have received one dose of the COVID-19 vaccine, of which five (5) are fully vaccinated.

3. We have recorded one thousand nine hundred and eighty-four (1984) new recoveries.

4. We now have twenty-four thousand six hundred and seventy (24 670) active cases. Five hundred and thirty-two (532) are hospitalized, of which ninety-seven (97) are in Intensive Care Units (ICUs).

Oshakati district recorded the highest number of deaths with seventeen (17) deaths in total, followed by Windhoek district with seven (7) deaths, Gobabis district with five (5) deaths, and Swakopmund district with one (1) death reported. Among the reported deaths, seventeen (17) occurred in June, nine (9) occurred between 05-11 July 2021 and only four (4) occurred during the reporting period. One (1) home death in Gobabis was recorded. None of the reported thirty (30) deaths were vaccinated.
