UPDATE BY DR. KALUMBI SHANGULA, MINISTER OF HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES ON COVID-19 IN NAMIBIA.

19 September 2021

1. We announce eighty-nine (89) new COVID-19 confirmed cases from one thousand three hundred and twenty-six (1 326) results in the last twenty-four (24) hours reporting cycle, which represents 6.7% positivity ratio. The sex distribution is fifty-three (53) females and thirty-six (36) males. The age range is from one (1) year to one hundred and thirteen (113) years. The new COVID-19 cases are geographically distributed as follows:

- 2. Of the confirmed cases, fifty (50) are learners, of which twenty-five (25) are from Shidute Combined School in Enhana and twelve (12) from Otjiuaneho Primary School in Gobabis district. The rest are from different schools. Three (3) teachers and one (1) healthcare worker are among the positive cases. None of the confirmed cases is vaccinated.
- 3. We have recorded eight (8) new recoveries from two regions:

- 7. By 18 September 2021, a total of **243 807** people have received one dose of the COVID-19 vaccine, while **155 427** had received two doses, as depicted on tables 5 and 6 below.
