UPDATE BY DR. KALUMBI SHANGULA, MINISTER OF HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES ON COVID-19 IN NAMIBIA.

20 September 2021

1. We announce one hundred (100) new COVID-19 confirmed cases from one thousand four hundred and forty-eight (1 448) results in the last twenty-four (24) hours reporting cycle, which represents 7% positivity ratio. The sex distribution is sixty-one (61) females and thirty-nine (39) males. The age range is from one (1) year to ninety-one (91) years. The new COVID-19 cases are geographically distributed as follows:

- 2. Of the confirmed cases, fifty-seven (57) are learners, of which sixteen (16) are from Kapombo Combined School in Engela district and eleven (11) from Onambala Combined School in Tsandi district. The rest are from different schools. Five (5) teachers and one (1) healthcare worker are among the positive cases. None of the confirmed cases is vaccinated.
- 3. We have recorded one hundred and nineteen (119) new recoveries from four regions:

4. The number of active cases are now one thousand three hundred and eight (1 308). Ninetynine (99) are hospitalized, of which fifteen (15) are in ICU.

- 5. We are reporting one death, a 26 years female from Windhoek district, with known comobidies, passed away on 13 September 2021 at home. She had received Sinopharm vaccine, number of doses are not specified.
- 6. By 19 September 2021, a total of **245 578** people have received one dose of the COVID-19 vaccine, of which **824** have received the Jansen & Johnson vaccine, which is only a one-dose vaccine, while **156 833** had received two doses. Therefore, **157 657** have completed the vaccination, as depicted on tables 5 and 6 below.

8. **Key Message**

 We have taken note of people seeking COVID-19 testing for traveling purpose coming to be swabbed at the state hospitals. People seeking COVID-19 test for traveling purposes are tested at own cost. Therefore they should be swabbed at the laboratories of their choice and not at the hospital. Let's follow set protocols, to avoid unnecessary delays.
