UPDATE BY DR. KALUMBI SHANGULA, MINISTER OF HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES ON COVID-19 IN NAMIBIA.

28 July 2021 WINDHOEK

1. We announce three hundred and twenty-six (326) new COVID-19 confirmed cases from one thousand eight hundred and six (1 806) results in the last twenty-four (24) hours, which represents 18% positivity ratio. The gender distribution is one hundred and eighty-one (181) females and one hundred and forty-five (145) males. The age ranges from eight (8) days to one hundred and one (101) years. The new cases are distributed as follows:

- 2. We are reporting cases from thirteen (13) regions, with Khomas region reporting the highest number of cases, accounting for 18% of the confirmed cases followed by Oshana 17% and Otjozondjupa 14%. Among the confirmed cases are twenty-nine (29) learners, three (3) teachers and thirteen (13) health care workers.
- 3. A total of seven (7) people who tested positive have been vaccinated, of those, one (1) have received two doses.
- 4. We have recorded four hundred and eighty-one (481) new recoveries.

5. We now have twenty thousand five hundred and three (20 503) active cases. Four hundred and sixty (460) are hospitalized, of which eighty (80) are in Intensive Care Unit (ICU).

- 7. Oshakati district reported the highest number of deaths with eight (8) deaths, followed by Swakopmund district with six (6) deaths, Rehoboth, Tsandi, and Otjiwarongo districts with four (4) deaths each, Windhoek and Onandjokwe districts with three (3) deaths each, Okahao, Outapi, Walvis Bay, and Grootfontein districts with two (2) deaths each, and Opuwo, Outjo, and Rundu districts with one (1) death each. Six (6) deaths reported today occurred at home: four (4) from Rehoboth, one (1) from Tsandi, and one (1) from Windhoek. Three (3) were reported as dead on arrival: one (1) from Tsandi and two (2) from Grootfontein. None of the deaths reported today was vaccinated.
- 8. All forty-three (43) deaths being reported today occurred in July 2021: thirteen (13) demised between 09-19 July, twenty-four (24) demised between 20-26 July, and six (6) demised between 27-28 July (within 24 hours of this report).
- 9. Tables 5 and 6 below show the number of people vaccinated with Sinopharm and AstraZeneca vaccines.
