UPDATE BY DR. KALUMBI SHANGULA, MINISTER OF HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES ON COVID-19 IN NAMIBIA.

30 July 2021 WINDHOEK

1. We announce four hundred and ninety-three (493) new COVID-19 confirmed cases from two thousand three hundred and forty-three (2 343) results in the last twenty-four (24) hours, which represents 21% positivity ratio. The gender distribution is two hundred and fifty-three (253) females and two hundred and forty (240) males. The age ranges from three (3) days to one hundred and two (102) years. The new COVID-19 cases are geographically distributed as follows:

- 2. We are reporting cases from fourteen (14) regions, with Oshikoto region reporting the highest number of cases, accounting for 18% of the total confirmed cases. Among the confirmed cases are forty-one (41) learners, thirteen (13) teachers, five (5) students, and nine (9) health care workers.
- 3. Of all confirmed cases, eleven (11), representing 2% are reported to have received a dose of the COVID-19 vaccine, of which only one (1) case received two doses.
- 4. We have recorded six hundred and ninety-four (694) new recoveries.

5. We now have twenty thousand six hundred and seventeen (20 617) active cases. Four hundred and forty (440) are hospitalized, of which eighty-five (85) are in Intensive Care Unit (ICU).

- 7. Rundu district reported the highest number of deaths with eight (8) deaths, followed by Windhoek and Engela districts with five (5) deaths each, Gobabis, Oshikuku, and Oshakati districts with four (4) deaths each, Katima Mulilo district with three (3) deaths, Outjo, Usakos, Khorixas, and Eenhana districts with two (2) deaths each, and Tsandi, Okahao, Swakopmund and Walvis Bay districts with one (1) death each.
- 8. Eight (8) of the deaths reported today occurred at home: four (4) from Gobabis, three (3) from Rundu and one (1) from Oshikuku.
- 9. All forty-five (45) deaths being reported today occurred in July 2021: four (4) demised between 11-29 July, twenty-nine (29) demised between 21-28 July, and twelve (12) demised between 29-30 July, that is within 24 hours of this report.
- 10. In total, **162 596** people have received at least one dose of the COVID-19 vaccine, while **48 814** have received two doses and regarded as fully vaccinated, as depicted in table 5 and 6 below:

12. **Key Messages**
