UPDATE BY DR. KALUMBI SHANGULA, MINISTER OF HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES ON COVID-19 IN NAMIBIA

2 June 2022 WINDHOEK

1. We announce two hundred and fifty-six (256) positive cases from one thousand three hundred and sixty-three (1 363) results in the last twenty-four (24) hour reporting cycle, representing a 18.8% positivity ratio. Of these positive cases, two hundred and thirty-two (232) are new cases and twenty-four (24) are reinfections. The sex distribution is one hundred and forty-three (143) females of which one hundred and thirty (130) are new cases and one hundred and thirteen (113) males of which one hundred and two (102) are new cases. The age ranges from five (5) months to eighty-three (83) years.

- 2. Cases are reported from twelve (12) regions. Among the confirmed cases, are thirty (30) learners from different schools, seven (7) health care workers, seven (7) students and two (2) teachers.
- 3. Five (5) cases have received one (1) dose of COVID-19 vaccine, forty-one (41) cases are fully vaccinated of which twelve (12) have received a booster dose of COVID-19 vaccine, twenty (20) cases are not eligible, and one hundred and ninety (190) cases are not vaccinated.
- 4. One hundred and thirty-nine (139) cases from four (5) regions have recovered.

5. The number of active cases is two thousand one hundred and twenty-three (2 123). Sixty (60) cases are currently hospitalized in ten (10) regions of which six (6) are in ICU. Three (3) of the hospitalized cases have received one dose of the COVID-19 vaccine and five (5) are fully vaccinated, and none of the ICU admissions is vaccinated.

- 6. We are reporting one (1) COVID-19 death. A 66-years-old female from Omaruru district died at a health facility on 31 May 2022. The deceased case was not vaccinated.
- 7. By 1 June 2022, a total of **467 147** people aged 18 years and older have received one dose of the COVID-19 vaccine, representing **32.0%** of the target population (1 471 973). A total of **145 590** have received the Johnson & Johnson vaccine, while **263 314** adults have received two doses of other vaccine types. Hence, **408 904** adults have completed their vaccination, translating to **28.0 %** of the target population.
- 8. A total of one hundred and twenty-eight (128) individuals have received component one of the Sputnik V vaccine and seventy-six (76) have received component two of the same vaccine. Hence, a total of two hundred and four (204) doses of Sputnik V were administered. This is included in the grand totals above.
- 9. Twenty-two thousand nine hundred and forty-seven (22 947) children aged 12-17 years have received one dose of the Pfizer vaccine, representing 7.5% of the target population (307 298). Of these, eleven thousand four hundred and ninety-nine (11 499) are fully vaccinated. Hence, the cumulative number of people vaccinated with the first dose of the

COVID-19 vaccine for both adults and children is **490 094** of which **420 403** are fully vaccinated, translating to **24.0%** of the total target population (1 779 271).

10. Sixty-seven thousand one hundred and ninety-nine (67 199) people have received a vaccine booster dose. Details of vaccinations are presented in tables 4, 5, 6, and 7 below.
