SERVICES ON COVID-19 IN NAMIBIA**

1. We announce one hundred and ninety-seven (**197**) positive cases from nine hundred and seventy-two (**972**) results in the last twenty-four (24) hour reporting cycle, representing a 20.3% positivity ratio. Of these cases, one hundred and eighty-four (184) are new cases and thirteen (13) are reinfections. The sex distribution is one hundred (100) females of which ninety-three (93) are new cases and ninety-seven (97) males of which ninety-one (91) are new cases. The age ranges from two (2) months to eighty-four (84) years.

2. Cases are reported from thirteen (13) regions. Among the confirmed cases, are ten (10) learners from different schools, six (6) health care workers, five (5) teacher and three (3) students.

Three (3) cases have received one (1) dose of COVID-19 vaccine, twenty-two (22) cases are fully vaccinated of which sixteen (16) have received a booster dose of COVID-19 vaccine, fifteen (15) cases are not eligible, and one hundred and fifty-seven (157) cases are not vaccinated.

3. One hundred and twenty (120) cases from four (4) regions have recovered.

4. The number of active cases is two thousand two hundred (2 200). Sixty-seven (67) are hospitalized of which seven (7) are in ICU. Three (3) cases have received one dose of the vaccine and three (3) are fully vaccinated, and none of the ICU admissions is vaccinated.

5. We have not recorded death during the period under review
6. By 2 June 2022, a total of **467 234** people aged 18 years and older have received one dose of the COVID-19 vaccine, representing **32.0%** of the target population (1 471 973). A total of **145 652** have received the Johnson & Johnson vaccine, while **263 336** adults have received two doses of other vaccine types. Hence, **408 988** adults have completed their vaccination, translating to **28.0 %** of the target population.
7. A total of one hundred and twenty-eight (**128**) individuals have received component one of the Sputnik V vaccine and seventy-six (**76**) have received component two of the same vaccine. Hence, a total of two hundred and four (**204**) doses of Sputnik V were administered. This is included in the grand totals above.
8. Twenty-two thousand nine hundred and seventy-one (**22 971**) children aged 12-17 years have received one dose of the Pfizer vaccine, representing **7.5%** of the target population (307 298). Of these, eleven thousand five hundred and fifteen (**11 515**) are fully vaccinated. Hence, the cumulative number of people vaccinated with the first dose of the COVID-19 vaccine for both adults and children is **490 205** of which **420 503** are fully vaccinated, translating to **24.0%** of the total target population (1 779 271).

9. Sixty-seven thousand two hundred and ninety-four (**67 294**) people have received a COVID-19 vaccine booster dose. Details of vaccinations are presented in tables 4, 5, 6, 7 and 8.
