**Check against Delivery*

1. We announce thirty-three (**33**) positive cases from eight hundred and twenty-three (**823**) results in the last twenty-four (24) hour reporting cycle, representing **4.0%** positivity ratio. Of these, thirty (30) are new and three (3) are reinfections. The sex distribution of the cases is nineteen (19) males of which eighteen (18) are new cases and fourteen (14) females of which twelve (12) are new cases. The age ranges from six (6) months to seventy-five (75) years.

2. Among the confirmed cases, nine (9) are learners from different schools in different regions, two (2) are students and one (1) is a teacher. Eleven (11) cases are fully vaccinated, while twenty-two (22) cases are not vaccinated.
3. Three (3) cases from two (2) region have recovered.

4. The number of active cases is two hundred and three-four (**234**). Six (**6**) cases are currently hospitalized in two (2) regions, none in ICU. All hospitalized cases are not vaccinated.

5. We are not reporting any death today.
6. By 4 March 2022, a total of **447 865 people** aged 18 years and older have received one dose of the COVID-19 vaccine, representing **30.4%** of the target population (1 471 973). A total of **132 536** have received the Johnson & Johnson vaccine, while **257 920** adults have received two doses of other vaccine types. Hence, **390 456** adults have completed their vaccination, translating to **26.5 %** of the target population.
7. A total of one hundred and twenty-eight (**128**) individuals have received component one of Sputnik V vaccine and seventy-six (**76**) have received component two of the same vaccine. Hence, a total of two hundred and four (**204**) doses of Sputnik V were administered. This is included in the grand totals above.
8. Fourteen thousand six hundred and twenty-seven (**14 627**) children aged 12-17 years have received one dose of the Pfizer vaccine, representing **4.8%** of the target population (307 298). Of these, five thousand eight hundred and eleven (**5 811**) are fully vaccinated. Hence, the cumulative number of people vaccinated with the first dose of the COVID-19 vaccine for both adults and children is **462 492** of which **396 267** are fully vaccinated, translating to **22.2%** of the total target population (1 779 271).
9. Forty-five thousand five hundred and two (**45 502**) people have received a COVID-19 vaccine booster dose. Details of vaccinations are presented in tables 4, 5, 6, 7 and 8 below.
