SERVICES ON COVID-19 IN NAMIBIA

6 April 2022

**Check against Delivery*

1. We announce nineteen (**19**) new positive cases from six hundred and fifty-seven (**657**) results in the last twenty-four (24) hour reporting cycle, representing **2.9%** positivity ratio. The sex distribution of the cases is ten (10) females of which nine (9) males. The age ranges from two (2) years to ninety-one (91) years.

2. Among the confirmed cases, nine (9) are learners, one (1) is a student and one (1) is a health care worker. Six (6) cases are fully vaccinated of which one (1) has received a booster dose, while thirteen (13) cases are not vaccinated.
3. Seven (7) cases from Zambezi region have recovered.
4. The number of active cases is two hundred and forty-six (**246**). Fourteen (**14**) cases are currently hospitalized in six (6) regions, none in ICU. One (1) of the hospitalized cases has received one (1) dose of the COVID-19 vaccine while thirteen (13) hospitalized cases are not vaccinated.

5. We have not recorded death during the period under review.
6. By 5 March 2022, a total of **448 394 people** aged 18 years and older have received one dose of the COVID-19 vaccine, representing **30.5%** of the target population (1 471 973). A total of **132 874** have received the Johnson & Johnson vaccine, while **258 070** adults have received two doses of other vaccine types. Hence, **390 944** adults have completed their vaccination, translating to **26.6 %** of the target population.
7. A total of one hundred and twenty-eight (**128**) individuals have received component one of Sputnik V vaccine and seventy-six (**76**) have received component two of the same vaccine. Hence, a total of two hundred and four (**204**) doses of Sputnik V were administered. This is included in the grand totals above.

8. Fifteen thousand one hundred and forty-eight (**15 148**) children aged 12-17 years have received one dose of the Pfizer vaccine, representing **5.0%** of the target population (307 298). Of these, five thousand eight hundred and eight-four (**5 884**) are fully vaccinated. Hence, the cumulative number of people vaccinated with the first dose of the COVID-19 vaccine for both adults and children is **463 542** of which **396 828** are fully vaccinated, translating to **22.3%** of the total target population (1 779 271).
9. Forty-five thousand nine hundred and eighty-six (**45 986**) people have received a COVID-19 vaccine booster dose. Details of vaccinations are presented in tables 4, 5, 6, 7 and 8 below.
