UPDATE BY DR. KALUMBI SHANGULA, MINISTER OF HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES ON COVID-19 IN NAMIBIA

8 April 2022 WINDHOEK

*Check against Delivery

1. We announce seventeen (17) new positive cases from six hundred and ninety-five (695) results in the last twenty-four (24) hour reporting cycle, representing 2.4% positivity ratio. The sex distribution of the cases is fourteen (14) females and three (3) males. The age ranges from one (1) year to fifty-two (52) years.

- 2. Among the confirmed cases, three (3) are learners and one (1) is a teacher. One (1) case has received one (1) dose of COVID-19 vaccine and four (4) cases are fully vaccinated of which one (1) has received a booster dose, while twelve (12) cases are not vaccinated.
- 3. Eight (8) cases from four (4) regions have recovered.

4. The number of active cases is two hundred and sixty-two (262). Twelve (12) cases are hospitalized in six (6) regions. None is in ICU. All cases are not vaccinated.

- 5. We have not recorded death during the period under review.
- 6. By 8 March 2022, a total of **449 638 people** aged 18 years and older have received one dose of the COVID-19 vaccine, representing **30.5%** of the target population (1 471 973). A total of **133 803** have received the Johnson & Johnson vaccine, while **258 441 a**dults have received two doses of other vaccine types. Hence, **392 244** adults have completed their vaccination, translating to **26.6 %** of the target population.

- 7. A total of one hundred and twenty-eight (128) individuals have received component one of Sputnik V vaccine and seventy-six (76) have received component two of the same vaccine. Hence, a total of two hundred and four (204) doses of Sputnik V were administered. This is included in the grand totals above.
- 8. Sixteen thousand two hundred and eighty (16 280) children aged 12-17 years have received one dose of the Pfizer vaccine, representing 5.3% of the target population (307 298). Of these, six thousand three hundred and eight (6 308) are fully vaccinated. Hence, the cumulative number of people vaccinated with the first dose of the COVID-19 vaccine for both adults and children is 465 918 of which 398 552 are fully vaccinated, translating to 22.4% of the total target population (1 779 271).
- 9. Forty-seven thousand two hundred and eighteen (47 218) people have received COVID-19 vaccine booster dose. Details of vaccinations are presented in tables 4, 5, 6, 7 and 8.
