UPDATE BY DR. KALUMBI SHANGULA, MINISTER OF HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES ON COVID-19 IN NAMIBIA

08 June 2022 WINDHOEK

1. We announce one hundred and ninety-four (194) positive cases from one thousand two hundred and fifty-five (1 255) results in the last twenty-four (24) hour reporting cycle, representing a 15.5% positivity ratio. Of these, one hundred and eighty-one (181) are new and thirteen (13) are reinfections. The sex distribution is one hundred and ten (110) females of which one hundred and five (105) are new cases and eighty-four (84) males of which seventy-six (76) are new cases. The age ranges from five (5) days to one hundred and one (101) years.

- 2. Among the confirmed cases, are ten (10) health care workers, nine (9) learners from different schools, two (2) students, and two (2) teachers.
- 3. Seven (7) cases have received one dose of the COVID-19 vaccine, thirty-five (35) cases are fully vaccinated, twelve (12) have received a booster dose, fourteen (14) cases are not eligible, and one hundred and thirty-eight (138) cases are not vaccinated.
- 4. One hundred and forty-six (146) cases from seven (7) regions have recovered.

5. The number of active cases is two thousand and fifteen (2 015). Sixty-five (65) cases are currently hospitalized in nine (9) regions of which seven (7) are in ICU. Six (6) of the hospitalized cases are fully vaccinated, but none of the ICU admissions is vaccinated.

- 6. We are reporting two (2) deaths. A six (6) weeks old male from Khorixas district died at home on 26 May 2022 classified as a COVID-19 death. The deceased was not eligible for COVID-19 vaccination. The second is a Covid-19 related death of a 65 years old male from Swakopmund district who died at home on 5 June 2022. The deceased case was not vaccinated.
- 7. By 7 June 2022, a total of **468 255** people aged 18 years and older have received one dose of the COVID-19 vaccine, representing **32.0%** of the target population (1 471 973). A total of **146 378 have** received the Johnson & Johnson vaccine, while **263 653** adults have received two doses of other vaccine types. Hence, **410 031** adults have completed their vaccination, translating to **28.0 %** of the target population.
- 8. A total of one hundred and twenty-eight (128) individuals have received component one of the Sputnik V vaccine and seventy-six (76) have received component two of the same vaccine. Hence, a total of two hundred and four (204) doses of Sputnik V were administered. This is included in the grand totals above.
- 9. Twenty-three thousand one hundred and twenty-seven (23 127) children aged 12-17 years have received one dose of the Pfizer vaccine, representing 7.5% of the target population (307 298). Of these, eleven thousand six hundred and sixty-six (11 666) are fully vaccinated. Hence, the cumulative number of people vaccinated with the first dose of the COVID-19 vaccine for both adults and children is 491 382 of which 421 697 are fully vaccinated, translating to 24.0% of the total target population (1 779 271).
- 10. Sixty-eight thousand four hundred and eighty-two (**68 482**) people have received a COVID-19 vaccine booster dose. Details of vaccinations are presented in tables 4, 5, 6, 7, and 8 below.
