UPDATE BY DR. KALUMBI SHANGULA, MINISTER OF HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES ON COVID-19 IN NAMIBIA

11 April 2022 WINDHOEK

1. We announce thirteen (13) positive cases from five hundred and forty (540) results in the last twenty-four (24) hour reporting cycle, representing a 2.4% positivity ratio. Of these positive cases eleven (11) are new cases and two (2) are reinfection. The sex distribution of the cases is three (3) males and ten (10) females of which eight (8) are new cases. The age ranges from ten (10) years to sixty-four (64) years.

- 2. Among the confirmed cases, seven (7) are learners.
- 3. One (1) case received one (1) dose of COVID-19 vaccine and one (1) case is fully vaccinated and received a booster dose, while eleven (11) cases are not vaccinated
- 4. Fifteen (15) cases from two (2) regions have recovered.

5. The number of active cases is two hundred and ninety-six (296). Sixteen (16) cases are currently hospitalized in eight (8) regions. We have no ICU admissions. All hospitalized cases are not vaccinated.

- 6. We have not recorded death during the period under review.
- 7. By 10 March 2022, a total of **450 352 people** aged 18 years and older have received one dose of the COVID-19 vaccine, representing **31.0%** of the target population (1 471 973). A total of **134 259** have received the Johnson & Johnson vaccine, while **258 594 a**dults have received two doses of other vaccine types. Hence, **392 853** adults have completed their vaccination, translating to **27.0 %** of the target population.
- 8. A total of one hundred and twenty-eight (128) individuals have received component one of Sputnik V vaccine and seventy-six (76) have received component two of the same vaccine. Hence, a total of two hundred and four (204) doses of Sputnik V were administered. This is included in the grand totals above.
- 9. Sixteen thousand seven hundred and ninety-six (16 796) children aged 12-17 years have received one dose of the Pfizer vaccine, representing 5.4% of the target population (307 298). Of these, six thousand four hundred and fifty-one (6 451) are fully vaccinated. Hence, the cumulative number of people vaccinated with the first dose of the COVID-19 vaccine for both adults and children is 467 148 of which 399 304 are fully vaccinated, translating to 22.4% of the total target population (1 779 271).
- 10. Forty-seven thousand eight hundred and twenty-nine (47 829) people have received a COVID-19 vaccine booster dose. Details of vaccinations are presented in tables 4, 5, 6, 7 and 8 below.
