**UPDATE BY DR. KALUMBI SHANGULA, MINISTER OF HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES ON COVID-19 IN NAMIBIA.**

**11 November 2021**

**WINDHOEK**

*\*Check against Delivery*

1. We announce three (3) new COVID-19 confirmed cases from eight hundred and ten (810) results in the last twenty-four (24) hours reporting cycle, which represents **0.4%** positivity ratio. The sex distribution is two (2) females and one (1) male. The age range is from twenty-eight (28) years to sixty-four (64) years. The new COVID-19 cases are geographically distributed as follows:

2. Among the confirmed cases is one (1) health care worker. None of the cases is vaccinated.
3. We have recorded twenty-six (26) new recoveries from four (4) regions:

4. The number of active cases is one hundred and forty (140). Fifteen (15) are hospitalized, of which two (2) are in Intensive Care Unit (ICU). Three hospitalized patients have received two doses of COVID-19 vaccine including one in ICU.

6. We have not recorded any death.
7. By 10 November 2021, a total of **343 488** people have received one dose of the COVID-19 vaccine, of which **63 551** have received the Janssen & Johnson vaccine, which is only administered as one dose, while **216 214** had received two doses. Therefore, **279 765** have completed the vaccination, as depicted on tables 4 and 5 below:
