1. We announce twenty-seven (**27**) positive cases from nine hundred and ninety-four (**994**) results in the last twenty-four (24) hour reporting cycle, which represents **2.7%** positivity ratio. Out of the total confirmed cases, twenty-four (24) are new cases and three (3) are reinfections. The sex distribution of the cases is sixteen (16) females of which fourteen (14) are new cases and eleven (11) males of which ten (10) are new. The age range is from one (1) year to ninety-one (91) years.

2. We are reporting cases from 10 regions, with more cases (5) recorded in Khomas region, constituting 18.5% of the total cases.
3. Among the confirmed cases are seven (7) learners and two (2) students. One (1) case received one dose of the COVID-19 vaccines, two (2) are fully vaccinated while one hundred and twenty-four (24) cases are not vaccinated, accounting for **88.9%** of the total confirmed cases.
4. Twenty-six (**26**) cases from five (5) regions have recovered.

5. The number of active cases is two thousand eight hundred and fifteen (**2 815**). Sixty (**63**)

cases are currently hospitalized across twelve (12) regions. One (1) of the hospitalized cases have received one dose of the COVID-19 vaccine, five (5) are fully vaccinated, while fifty-seven (57) are not vaccinated constituting **90.5%** of all hospitalized cases. Four (4) cases are in Intensive Care Unit (ICU), of which one (1) is fully vaccinated. The rest of ICU admissions are not vaccinated.

7. The two deaths occurred between 07-29 January 2022. None of the deceased was vaccinated.

8. By 11 February 2022, a total of **425 397** people aged 18 years and older have received one dose of the COVID-19 vaccine, representing **28.9%** of the target population (1 471 973). A total of **118 979** have received the Johnson & Johnson vaccine, while **246 933** adults have received two doses of other vaccine types. Hence, **365 912** adults have completed their vaccination, translating to **24.9%** of the target population.
9. Seven thousand three hundred and eighty-seven (**7 387**) children aged 12-17 years have received one dose of the Pfizer vaccine, representing **2.4%** of the target population (307 298). Of these, one thousand three hundred and sixty (**1 360**) are fully vaccinated. Hence, the cumulative number of people vaccinated with the first dose of the COVID-19 vaccine for both adults and children is **432 784** of which **367 272** are fully vaccinated, translating to **20.6%** of the total target population (1 779 271).
10. Twenty thousand seven hundred and thirty-five (**20 735**) people have received a COVID-19 vaccine booster dose. Details of vaccinations are presented in tables 5, 6, 7, 8 and 9.
