1. We announce fourteen (**14**) new positive cases from five hundred and nineteen (**519**) results in the last twenty-four (24) hour reporting cycle, representing a **2.7%** positivity ratio. The sex distribution is seven (7) females and seven (7) males. The age ranges from one (1) year old to seventy-three (73) years.

2. Cases are reported from six (6) regions. Among the confirmed cases are two (2) learners.
3. One (1) case is fully vaccinated and has received a booster dose, four (4) cases are not eligible for vaccination and nine (9) cases are not vaccinated.
4. Twenty-two (22) cases from five (5) regions have recovered.

5. The number of active cases is one hundred and thirty-three (133). Twenty-five (25) cases are currently hospitalized in six (6) regions of which one (1) is in ICU. None of the hospitalized cases is vaccinated.

6. No death was reported for the period under review.
7. By 12 July 2022, a total of **486 800** people aged 18 years and older have received one dose of the COVID-19 vaccine, representing **33.0%** of the target population (1 471 973). A total of **160 997** have received the Johnson & Johnson vaccine, while **266 378** adults have received two doses of other vaccine types. Hence, **427 375** adults have completed their vaccination, translating to **29.0 %** of the target population.
8. A total of one hundred and twenty-eight (**128**) individuals have received component one of the Sputnik V vaccine and seventy-six (**76**) have received component two of the same vaccine. Hence, a total of two hundred and four (**204**) doses of Sputnik V were administered. This is included in the grand totals above.
9. Twenty-four thousand four hundred and ninety (**24 490**) children aged 12-17 years have received one dose of the Pfizer vaccine, representing **8.0%** of the target population (307 298). Of these, twelve thousand four hundred and sixty-seven (**12 467**) are fully vaccinated. Hence, the cumulative number of people vaccinated with the first dose of the COVID-19 vaccine for both adults and children is **511 290** of which **439 842** are fully vaccinated, translating to **24.7%** of the total target population (1 779 271).
10. Seventy-eight thousand five hundred and eighty-seven (**78 587**) people have received a COVID-19 vaccine booster dose. Details of vaccinations are presented in tables 4, 5, 6, 7, and 8 below.
