**Check against Delivery*

1. We announce four (4) new COVID-19 confirmed cases from seven hundred and twenty-five (725) results in the last twenty-four (24) hours reporting cycle, which represents 0.6% positivity ratio. The sex distribution is three (3) females and one (1) male. The age range is from twelve (12) years to eighty-eight (88) years. The new COVID-19 cases are geographically distributed as follows:

2. Among the confirmed cases are two (2) learners from two different schools and one (1) health care worker. None of the cases is vaccinated.
3. It is noted that twelve (12) regions did not record any new Covid-19 case over the last twenty-four (24) reporting cycle.
4. We have recorded three (3) new recoveries from Ohangwena region.
5. The number of active cases is one hundred and thirty-one (131). Fifteen (15) are hospitalized, of which two (2) are in Intensive Care Unit (ICU). None of the hospitalized including ICU cases is vaccinated.

6. We have not recorded death for the last five (5) consecutive days.
7. By 12 November 2021, a total of 345 607 people have received one dose of the COVID-19 vaccine, of which 64 996 have received the Janssen & Johnson vaccine, which is only administered as one dose, while 217 700 had received two doses. Therefore, 282 696 have completed the vaccination, as depicted on tables 3 and 4 below:
