**UPDATE BY DR. KALUMBI SHANGULA, MINISTER OF HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES ON COVID-19 IN NAMIBIA**

**14 June 2022**

**WINDHOEK**

1. We announce eighty-four (**84**) positive cases from eight hundred and eighty-three (**883**) results in the last twenty-four (24) hour reporting cycle, representing a 9.5% positivity ratio. Of these positive cases, seventy-one (71) are new cases and thirteen (13) are reinfections. The sex distribution is forty-nine (49) males of which forty-two (42) are new cases and thirty-five (35) females of which twenty-nine (29) are new cases. The age ranges from one (1) year to one hundred twelve (112) years.

2. Cases are reported from twelve (12) regions. Among the confirmed cases, are four (4) learners from different schools, four (4) health care workers, three (3) teachers, and two (2) students.
3. Six (6) cases have received one dose of the COVID-19 vaccine, seventeen (17) cases are fully vaccinated of which three (3) have received a booster dose of the COVID-19 vaccine, six (6) cases are not eligible, fifty-five (55) cases are not vaccinated.
4. Four hundred and fifty-three (453) cases from nine (9) regions have recovered.

5. The number of active cases is one thousand five hundred and eighteen (1 518). Forty-eight (48) cases are currently hospitalized in nine (9) regions of which three (3) are in ICU. Seven (7) of the hospitalized case is fully vaccinated, and none of the ICU admissions is vaccinated.

6. We are reporting two (2) COVID-19 death. A 102-year-old female from Oshakati died at the health facility on the 11<sup>th</sup> of June 2022. A 33-year-old male from Oshakati district died at the health facility on the 12<sup>th</sup> of June 2022. The deceased were not vaccinated.
7. By 13 June 2022, a total of **469 535** people aged 18 years and older have received one dose of the COVID-19 vaccine, representing **32.0%** of the target population (1 471 973). A total of **147 231** have received the Johnson & Johnson vaccine, while **264 013** adults have received two doses of other vaccine types. Hence, **411 244** adults have completed their vaccination, translating to **28.0 %** of the target population.
8. A total of one hundred and twenty-eight (**128**) individuals have received component one of the Sputnik V vaccine and seventy-six (**76**) have received component two of the same vaccine. Hence, a total of two hundred and four (**204**) doses of Sputnik V were administered. This is included in the grand totals above.

9. Twenty-three thousand three hundred and thirty-four (**23 344**) children aged 12-17 years have received one dose of the Pfizer vaccine, representing **8.0%** of the target population (307 298). Of these, eleven thousand eight hundred and twenty-one (**11 821**) are fully vaccinated. Hence, the cumulative number of people vaccinated with the first dose of the COVID-19 vaccine for both adults and children is **492 879** of which **423 065** are fully vaccinated, translating to **24.0%** of the total target population (1 779 271).
10. Sixty-nine thousand nine hundred and forty-two (**69 942**) people have received a COVID-19 vaccine booster dose. Details of vaccinations are presented in tables 4, 5, 6, 7, and 8.
