UPDATE BY DR. KALUMBI SHANGULA, MINISTER OF HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES ON COVID-19 IN NAMIBIA.

14 December 2021

WINDHOEK

1. We announce seven hundred and ten (710) new positive cases from two thousand seven hundred and sixty-five (2 765) results in the last twenty-four (24) hours reporting cycle, which represents 25.7% positivity ratio. The sex distribution is three hundred and fifty-six (356) females and three hundred and fifty-four (354) males. The age ranges from one (1) month to eighty-two (82) years.

- 2. Khomas region recorded the highest number of new cases, totalling three hundred and twenty-eight (328), making up 46.2% of the total confirmed cases.
- 3. Among the confirmed cases are sixty (60) learners, sixteen (16) health care workers fourteen (14) students, , and eight (8) teachers. Twenty-four (24) cases have received one (1) dose of the COVID-19 vaccine and eighty-seven (87) cases are fully vaccinated. A total of 599 which constitutes 84.3% are unvaccinated.
- 4. We are reporting fifty-eight (58) new recoveries from nine (9) regions.

5. The number of active cases are four thousand four hundred and thirty-nine (4 439). Hospitalized cases gradually picking up as there are now one hundred and ten (110) across eleven (11) regions, of which ten (10) are in Intensive Care Unit (ICU). Eleven (11) of the hospitalized cases are fully vaccinated. All cases in ICU are not vaccinated.

- 6. We are reporting one (1) COVID-19 death from Outapi district. A male aged 52 years died at a health facility on 12 December 2021. The deceased was not vaccinated.
- 7. By 13 December 2021, a total of **390 615** people have received one dose of the COVID-19 vaccine, representing **21.3%** of the target population including four hundred and sixteen (**416**) children aged 12-17 years. A total of **95 838** have received the Johnson & Johnson vaccine, which is administered as one dose, while **233 250** adults had received two doses of other vaccines. Therefore, **329 088** have completed the vaccination, translating to **21.9.0%** of the target population. Seven hundred and forty-nine (**749**) people have received 3rd doses of Sinopharm. Details of vaccinations are presented in tables 4, 5, 6, 7 and 8 below:
