UPDATE BY DR. KALUMBI SHANGULA, MINISTER OF HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES ON COVID-19 IN NAMIBIA

15 June 2022

**Check against Delivery*

1. We announce one hundred and four (**104**) positive cases from eight hundred and forty-one (**841**) results in the last twenty-four (24) hour reporting cycle, representing a 12.4% positivity ratio. Of these positive cases, eighty-nine (89) are new cases and fifteen (15) are reinfections. The sex distribution is fifty-eight (58) females of which fifty-one (51) are new cases and forty-six (46) males of which thirty-eight (38) are new cases. The age ranges from one (1) year to ninety (90) years.

2. Cases are reported from ten (10) regions. Among the confirmed cases, are seven (7) learners from different schools, four (4) health care workers, two (2) students and one (1) teacher.
3. Two (2) cases have received one dose of the COVID-19 vaccine, twenty-four (24) cases are fully vaccinated of which three (3) have received a booster dose of the COVID-19 vaccine, four (4) cases are not eligible, seventy-four (74) cases are not vaccinated.
4. Two hundred and ninety-four (294) cases from nine (9) regions have recovered.

5. The number of active cases is one thousand three hundred and twenty-six (1 326). Fifty-three (53) cases are currently hospitalized in nine (9) regions of which two (2) are in ICU. Seven (7) of the hospitalized case is fully vaccinated, and none of the ICU admissions is vaccinated.

6. We are reporting two (2) COVID-19 death. An 84-year-old female from Oshakati district died at the health facility on the 14th of June 2022. The deceased was not vaccinated. An 81-year-old female from Nyangana district died at home on the 12th of June 2022. The deceased was not vaccinated.
7. By 14 June 2022, a total of **470 038** people aged 18 years and older have received one dose of the COVID-19 vaccine, representing **32.0%** of the target population (1 471 973). A total of **147 612** have received the Johnson & Johnson vaccine, while **264 136** adults have received two doses of other vaccine types. Hence, **411 748** adults have completed their vaccination, translating to **28.0 %** of the target population.
8. A total of one hundred and twenty-eight (**128**) individuals have received component one of the Sputnik V vaccines and seventy-six (**76**) have received component two of the same vaccine. Hence, a total of two hundred and four (**204**) doses of Sputnik V were administered. This is included in the grand totals above.
9. Twenty-three thousand four hundred (**23 400**) children aged 12-17 years have received one dose of the Pfizer vaccine, representing **8.0%** of the target population (307 298). Of these, eleven thousand eight hundred and fifty-one (**11 851**) are fully vaccinated. Hence, the cumulative number of people vaccinated with the first dose of the COVID-19 vaccine for both adults and children is **493 438** of which **423 599** are fully vaccinated, translating to **24.0%** of the total target population (1 779 271).
10. Seventy thousand four hundred thirty-four (**70 434**) people have received a COVID-19 vaccine booster dose. Details of vaccinations are presented in tables 4, 5, 6, 7, and 8 below.
