UPDATE BY DR. KALUMBI SHANGULA, MINISTER OF HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES ON COVID-19 IN NAMIBIA.

15 November 2021

WINDHOEK

1. We announce seven (7) new COVID-19 confirmed cases from one thousand five hundred and twenty-three (1 523) results in the last twenty-four (24) hours reporting cycle, which represents 0.5% positivity ratio. The sex distribution is four (4) males and three (3) females. The age range is from twenty (20) years to fifty-four (54) years. The new COVID-19 cases are geographically distributed as follows:

- 2. Of the confirmed cases two (2) have received one (1) dose of the COVID-19 vaccine and two (2) have received two (2) doses.

4. The number of active cases is one hundred and twenty-four (124). Eleven (11) are hospitalized, of which three (3) are in Intensive Care Unit (ICU). None of the hospitalized including ICU cases is vaccinated.

- 6. We are reporting one (1) COVID-19 death from Rundu district. An unvaccinated female aged between 60-69 died at a health facility on the 14 November 2021.
- 7. By 14 November 2021, a total of **346 454** people have received one dose of the COVID-19 vaccine, of which **65 531** have received the Jansseadministered as one dose, while **218 227** had received two doses. Therefore, **283 758** have completed the vaccination, as depicted on tables 4 and 5 below:
