1. We announce five (5) new COVID-19 confirmed cases from one thousand five hundred and fifty-two (1 552) results in the last twenty-four (24) hours reporting cycle, which represents 0.3% positivity ratio. The age ranges between twenty-two (22) and fifty-four (54) years. New COVID-19 cases are geographically distributed as follows:

- 6. We are reporting one (1) COVID-19 related death from Outjo district. A female aged between 30-39 years died at a health facility on the 16 November 2021, within 24 reporting cycle. The deceased case is not vaccinated.
- 7. By 16 November 2021, a total of **350 082** people have received one dose of the COVID-19 vaccine, of which **68 001** have received the Janssen administered as one dose, while **220 483** had received two doses. Therefore, **288 484** have completed the vaccination, as depicted on tables 4 and 5 below:
