UPDATE BY DR. KALUMBI SHANGULA, MINISTER OF HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES ON COVID-19 IN NAMIBIA.

**18 November 2021** 

**WINDHOEK** 

- 1. We announce two (2) new COVID-19 confirmed cases from nine hundred and sixty-seven (967) results in the last twenty-four (24) hours reporting cycle, which represents 0.2% positivity ratio. The new cases are in equal sex distribution of one (1) for each. The age ranges between forty (40) and forty-four (44) years. Both new COVID-19 cases are from Windhoek district, Khomas region.
- 2. Of the confirmed cases one (1) has received one (1) dose of the COVID19 vaccine.
- 3. We have recorded twenty-eight (28) new recoveries from three (3) regions:

4. The number of active cases is sixty-four (64). Eleven (11) are hospitalized, of which two (2) are in Intensive Care Unit (ICU). None of the hospitalized including ICU cases is vaccinated.

By 17 November 2021, a total of **352 187** people have received one dose of the COVID-19 vaccine, of which **69 523** have received the Janssen administered as one dose, while **221 536** had received two doses. Therefore, **291 059** have completed the vaccination, as depicted on tables 3 and 4 below:
