1. We announce six (6) new COVID-19 confirmed cases from one thousand three hundred and thirty-five (1 335) results in the last twenty-four (24) hours reporting cycle, which represents 0.4% positivity ratio. The sex distribution is five (5) females and one (1) male. The age ranges between five (5) years and thirty-five (35) years.

- 2. Among the confirmed cases are two (2) learners and two (2) health care workers. One (1) case received one dose of the COVID-19 vaccine.
- 3. We have recorded two (2) new recoveries, one each from Kunene and Erongo regions.
- 4. The number of active cases is seventy-six (76). Nine (9) are hospitalized, of which one (1) is in Intensive Care Unit (ICU). None of the hospitalized including ICU cases is vaccinated.

By 21 November 2021, a total of **356 714** people have received one dose of the COVID-19 vaccine, of which **72 696** have received the Janssen vaccine, administered as one dose, while **223 428** had received two doses. Therefore, **296 124** have completed the vaccination, as depicted on tables 3 and 4 below:
