## UPDATE BY DR. KALUMBI SHANGULA, MINISTER OF HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES ON COVID-19 IN NAMIBIA

23 June 2022 WINDHOEK

1. We announce forty-seven (47) positive cases from seven hundred and twenty-eight (728) results in the last twenty-four (24) hour reporting cycle, representing a 6.5% positivity ratio. Of these positive cases, forty-three (43) are new cases and four (4) are reinfections. The sex distribution is twenty-five (25) males of which twenty-one (21) are new cases and twenty-two (22) females. The age ranges from one (1) year to seventy-five (75) years.

- 2. Cases are reported from eleven (11) regions. Among the confirmed cases are five (5) students and two (2) health care workers.
- 3. Six (6) cases have received one dose of the COVID-19 vaccine, sixteen (16) cases are fully vaccinated of which two (2) have received a booster dose, one (1) case is not eligible and twenty-four (24) cases are not vaccinated.
- 4. One hundred and forty-five (145) cases from seven (7) regions have recovered.

5. The number of active cases is five hundred and fifty (550). Thirty-three (33) cases are currently hospitalized in ten (10) regions of which two (2) are in ICU. One (1) of the hospitalized case has received one dose of the COVID-19 vaccine, six (6) are fully vaccinated, and none of the ICU admissions is vaccinated.

- 6. We are reporting two (2) COVID-19 deaths and one (1) COVID-19-related death. Two (2) of the deceased cases were not eligible for the COVID-19 vaccine and one (1) was not vaccinated.
  - An 82 years old male from Engela district died at home on 21 June 2022. This is a COVID-19 death.
  - A 9 years old female from Engela district died at a health facility on 4 June 2022. This is a COVID-19 related death.
  - A 10 months old female from Oshakati district died at a health facility on 21 June 2022. This is a COVID-19 death.
- 7. By 22 June 2022, a total of **473 260** people aged 18 years and older have received one dose of the COVID-19 vaccine, representing **32.2%** of the target population (1 471 973). A total of **150 069 have** received the Johnson & Johnson vaccine, while **264 871** adults have received two doses of other vaccine types. Hence, **414 940** adults have completed their vaccination, translating to **28.2 %** of the target population.
- 8. A total of one hundred and twenty-eight (128) individuals have received component one of the Sputnik V vaccines and seventy-six (76) have received component two of the same vaccine. Hence, a total of two hundred and four (204) doses of Sputnik V were administered. This is included in the grand totals above.
- 9. Twenty-three thousand eight hundred and forty-nine (23 849) children aged 12-17 years have received one dose of the Pfizer vaccine, representing 8.0% of the target population (307 298). Of these, twelve thousand and fifty-nine (12 059) are fully vaccinated. Hence, the cumulative number of people vaccinated with the first dose of the COVID-19 vaccine for both adults and children is 497 109 of which 426 999 are fully vaccinated, translating to 24.0% of the total target population (1 779 271).

10. Seventy-three thousand five hundred and ninety (**73 590**) people have received a COVID-19 vaccine booster dose. Details of vaccinations are presented in tables 4, 5, 6, 7, and 8 below.
