UPDATE BY DR. KALUMBI SHANGULA, MINISTER OF HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES ON COVID-19 IN NAMIBIA

24 June 2022

WINDHOEK *Check against Delivery We announce twenty-two (22) positive cases from five hundred and twenty-one (521) results in the last twenty-four (24) hour reporting cycle, representing a 4.2% positivity ratio. Of these cases, twenty (20) are new and two (2) are reinfections. The sex distribution is fifteen (15) females of which fourteen (14) are new and seven (7) males of six (6) are new cases. The age ranges from twenty-eight (28) years to eighty (80) years.

4. The number of active cases is five hundred and forty-eight (548). Forty-four (44) are hospitalized of which two (2) are in ICU. One (1) of the hospitalized case has received one dose of the vaccine; six (6) are fully vaccinated. None in ICU is vaccinated.

- 5. No death was reported for the period under review.
- By 22 June 2022, a total of 474 063 people aged 18 years and older have received one dose of the COVID-19 vaccine, representing 32.2% of the target population (1 471 973). A total of 150 554 have received the Johnson & Johnson vaccine, while 265 166 adults have received two doses of other vaccine types. Hence, 415 720 adults have completed their vaccination, translating to 28.2% of the target population.
- 7. A total of one hundred and twenty-eight (128) individuals have received component one of the Sputnik V vaccines and seventy-six (76) have received component two of the same vaccine. Hence, a total of two hundred and four (204) doses of Sputnik V were administered. This is included in the grand totals above.
- 8. Twenty-three thousand nine hundred and eighty-four (**23 984**) children aged 12-17 years have received one dose of the Pfizer vaccine, representing **8.0%** of the target population (307 298). Of these, twelve thousand one hundred and twenty-nine (**12 129**) are fully vaccinated. Hence, the cumulative number of people vaccinated with the first dose of the COVID-19 vaccine for both adults and children is **498 047** of which **427 849** are fully vaccinated, translating to **24.0%** of the total target population (1 779 271).
- Seventy- four thousand four hundred and sixteen (74 416) people have received a COVID-19 vaccine booster dose. Details of vaccinations are presented in tables 4, 5, 6, 7, and 8 below.
