**UPDATE BY DR. KALUMBI SHANGULA, MINISTER OF HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES ON COVID-19 IN NAMIBIA.**

**25 November 2021**

**WINDHOEK**

1. We announce eighteen (**18**) new COVID-19 confirmed cases from two thousand two hundred and fifty-eight (**2 258**) results in the last twenty-four (24) hours reporting cycle, which represents **0.8%** positivity ratio. The sex distribution is ten (**10**) females and eight (**8**) males. The age ranges between five (**5**) years and sixty-four (**64**) years.

2. Of the confirmed cases two are (2) students. Two (2) cases have received one (1) dose of the COVID-19 vaccine and four (4) cases have received two (2) doses.
3. We have recorded three (3) new recoveries, two (2) from Khomas region and one (1) from Hardap region.
4. The number of active cases is one hundred and two (**102**). Eleven (**11**) are hospitalized, of which two (2) is in Intensive Care Unit (ICU). None of the hospitalized including ICU cases is vaccinated.

6. We have not recorded any death during the reporting cycle period.
7. By 24 November 2021, a total of **362 831** people have received one dose of the COVID-19 vaccine, of which **77 483** have received the Janssen vaccine, administered as one dose, while **225 990** had received two doses. Therefore, **303 473** have completed the vaccination, as depicted on tables 3 and 4 below:
