UPDATE BY DR. KALUMBI SHANGULA, MINISTER OF HEALTH AND SOCIAL  
SERVICES ON COVID-19 IN NAMIBIA

27 June 2022

WINDHOEK

1. We announce forty (**40**) positive cases from four hundred and ninety-nine (**499**) results in the last twenty-four (24) hour reporting cycle, representing an **8.0%** positivity ratio. Of these positive cases, thirty-eight (38) are new cases and two (2) are reinfections. The sex distribution is twenty-four (24) males of which twenty-two (22) are new cases and sixteen (16) females all new cases. The age ranges from six (6) years to ninety-three (93) years.

2. Cases are reported from seven (7) regions. Among the confirmed cases are four (4) learners and one (1) student.
3. Three (3) cases have received one dose of the COVID-19 vaccine, ten (10) case are fully vaccinated of which two (2) cases received a booster dose, two (2) cases are not eligible and twenty-five (25) cases are not vaccinated.
4. Eight (8) cases from two (2) regions have recovered.

5. The number of active cases is five hundred and seventy-two (572). Forty-three (43) cases are currently hospitalized in eleven (11) regions of which four (4) are in ICU. One (1) of the hospitalized case has received one dose of the COVID-19 vaccine, six (6) are fully vaccinated, and none of the ICU admissions is vaccinated.

6. We are reporting one (1) COVID-19 related death. An 87 year old male from Windhoek district who died at the health facility on the 25<sup>th</sup> of June 2022 classified as a COVID-19 related death. The deceased was not vaccinated.
7. By 26 June 2022, a total of **474 699** people aged 18 years and older have received one dose of the COVID-19 vaccine, representing **32.2%** of the target population (1 471 973). A total of **150 921** have received the Johnson & Johnson vaccine, while **265 367** adults have received two doses of other vaccine types. Hence, **416 288** adults have completed their vaccination, translating to **28.3 %** of the target population.
8. A total of one hundred and twenty-eight (**128**) individuals have received component one of the Sputnik V vaccines and seventy-six (**76**) have received component two of the same vaccine. Hence, a total of two hundred and four (**204**) doses of Sputnik V were administered. This is included in the grand totals above.
9. Twenty-four thousand and fifty (**24 050**) children aged 12-17 years have received one dose of the Pfizer vaccine, representing **8.0%** of the target population (307 298). Of these, twelve thousand one hundred and seventy-two (**12 172**) are fully vaccinated. Hence, the cumulative number of people vaccinated with the first dose of the COVID-19 vaccine for both adults and children is **498 749** of which **428 460** are fully vaccinated, translating to **24.1%** of the total target population (1 779 271).
10. Seventy-five thousand and forty-nine (**75 049**) people have received a COVID-19 vaccine booster dose. Details of vaccinations are presented in tables 4, 5, 6, 7, and 8 below.
