UPDATE BY DR. KALUMBI SHANGULA, MINISTER OF HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES ON COVID-19 IN NAMIBIA.

27 September 2021

1. We announce one hundred and twenty (120) new COVID-19 confirmed cases from one thousand eight hundred and forty-seven (1 847) results in the last twenty-four (24) hours reporting cycle, which represents 6.5% positivity ratio. The sex distribution is sixty-five (65) females and fifty-five (55) males. The age range is from one (1) year to ninety-one (91) years. The new COVID-19 cases are geographically distributed as follows:

- 2. Of the confirmed cases, sixty-four (64) are learners of which twenty-two (22) are from Oshidute Combined School in Eenhana, eighteen from Epoli Combined School in Engela and the rest are from different schools. Three (3) teachers are among the positive cases.
- 3. Five (5) cases received one dose of the vaccines and two (2) received two doses.
- 4. We have recorded thirty-five (35) new recoveries from six (6) regions:

- 6. We are reporting zero (0) death. We are moving in the right direction.
- 7. By 26 September 2021, a total of **261 269** people have received one dose of the COVID-19 vaccine, of which **9 128** have received the Janssen & Johnson vaccine, which is only administered as one dose, while **167 720** had received two doses. Therefore, **176 848** have completed the vaccination, as depicted on tables 5 and 6 below.

9. **Key message**

- Of late, the numbers of new infections is sustained by the education institutions. During the last reporting cycle, sixty-four (64) learners and three (3) teachers tested positive for Covid-19. The schools most affected are those predominantly those in rural areas. This points to challenges in implementing and sustaining public health measures. I once again call on the education sector to strengthen preventive measures in schools.
- On the positive side, we have not recorded any death during the last six (6) days. All the death we have announced lately, happened earlier than six days. Let us build on this positive trend.
