UPDATE BY DR. KALUMBI SHANGULA, MINISTER OF HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES ON COVID-19 IN NAMIBIA.

27 November 2021

WINDHOEK *Check against Delivery We announce twenty (20) new COVID-19 confirmed cases from one thousand three hundred and twenty-two (1 322) results in the last twenty-four (24) hours reporting cycle, which represents 1.5% positivity ratio. The sex distribution is eleven (11) males and nine (9) females. The age ranges between fifteen (15) years and seventy-one (71) years.

 By 26 November 2021, a total of 365 473 people have received one dose of the COVID-19 vaccine, of which 79 459 have received the Janssen vaccine, administered as one dose, while 227 147 had received two doses. Therefore, 306 606 have completed the vaccination, as depicted on tables 4 and 5 below:

6. Key message

- Following the detection of the new variant of concern, named Omicron, it is noted that more new moderate and severe cases are being reported among youths. This is the group which is mainly not vaccinated
- We are seeinfg cases slowly increasing again. Basic preventive measures for Covid-19 remain the same: correctly wearing of face masks, regular hand hygiene, avoiding crowded places, observing physical distance, keeping indoor spaces well ventilated and most importantly get vaccinated to protect yourself and those around you.
- Regardless of the variant, interventions equally remains the same: testing, quarantine when exposed or when not feeling well, and isolate from others when infected.
