UPDATE BY DR. KALUMBI SHANGULA, MINISTER OF HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES ON COVID-19 IN NAMIBIA.

28 September 2021

1. We announce fifty-three (53) new COVID-19 confirmed cases from one thousand one hundred and sixty-six (1 166) results in the last twenty-four (24) hours reporting cycle, which represents 4.5% positivity ratio. The sex distribution is twenty-nine (29) females and twenty-four (24) males. The age range is from four (4) months to eighty-six (86) years old. The new COVID-19 cases are geographically distributed as follows:

- 4. We have recorded seventy-three (73) new recoveries from six (6) regions:

- 7. Five (5) deaths occurred in August 2021, three (3) occurred between 03-10 September 202, five (5) between 18-26 September 2021 and one (1) occurred on 27 September, within the 24-hours reporting period. All three under 10 years are reported from Katima Mulilo district. None of the deceased was vaccinated.
- 8. Seven of the deaths are home deaths. Five are from Katima Mulilo district and the remainder two are from Opuwo district.
- 9. By 27 September 2021, a total of **264 143** people have received one dose of the COVID-19 vaccine, of which **10 748** have received the Janssen & Johnson vaccine, which is only administered as one dose, while **169 614** had received two doses. Therefore, **180 362** have completed the vaccination, as depicted on tables 5 and 6 below.
