SERVICES ON COVID-19 IN NAMIBIA

29 June 2022

1. We announce eighteen (**18**) positive cases from five hundred and thirty (**530**) results in the last twenty-four (24) hour reporting cycle, representing a **3.4%** positivity ratio. Of these positive cases, sixteen (16) are new cases and two (2) are reinfections. The sex distribution is twelve (12) females of which ten (10) are new cases and six (6) males, all new cases. The age ranges from one (1) month to sixty-five (65) years.

2. Cases are reported from six (6) regions. Among the confirmed cases is one (1) health care worker.
3. Four (4) cases are fully vaccinated. One (1) case is not eligible and thirteen (13) cases are not vaccinated.
4. One hundred and seven (107) cases from six (6) regions have recovered.

5. The number of active cases is four hundred and twenty (420). Thirty (30) cases are currently hospitalized in ten (10) regions of which five (5) are in ICU. One (1) of the hospitalized cases has received one dose of the COVID-19 vaccine, two (2) are fully vaccinated, and none of the ICU admissions is vaccinated.

6. We are reporting one (1) COVID-19 death. A 74-years-old male from Karasburg district with known comorbidities, died at health facility on 25 June 2022. The deceased was fully vaccinated.
7. By 28 June 2022, a total of **475 158** people aged 18 years and older have received one dose of the COVID-19 vaccine, representing **32.3%** of the target population (1 471 973). A total of **151 259** have received the Johnson & Johnson vaccine, while **265 530** adults have received two doses of other vaccine types. Hence, **416 789** adults have completed their vaccination, translating to **28.3 %** of the target population.
8. A total of one hundred and twenty-eight (**128**) individuals have received component one of the Sputnik V vaccines and seventy-six (**76**) have received component two of the same vaccine. Hence, a total of two hundred and four (**204**) doses of Sputnik V were administered. This is included in the grand totals above.
9. Twenty-four thousand one hundred and twenty-eight (**24 128**) children aged 12-17 years have received one dose of the Pfizer vaccine, representing **8.0%** of the target population (307 298). Of these, twelve thousand two hundred and eight (**12 208**) are fully vaccinated. Hence, the cumulative number of people vaccinated with the first dose of the COVID-19 vaccine for both adults and children is **499 286** of which **428 997** are fully vaccinated, translating to **24.1%** of the total target population (1 779 271).
10. Seventy-five thousand eight hundred and fifty-four (**75 854**) people have received a COVID-19 vaccine booster dose. Details of vaccinations are presented in tables 4, 5, 6, 7, and 8 below.
