UPDATE BY DR. KALUMBI SHANGULA, MINISTER OF HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES ON COVID-19 IN NAMIBIA.

30 November 2021

1. We announce forty-five (45) new COVID-19 confirmed cases from one thousand five hundred and thirty-one (1 531) results in the last twenty-four (24) hours reporting cycle, which represents 2.9% positivity ratio. The sex distribution is twenty-nine (29) females and fifteen (15) males. The age ranges between three (3) days and seventy-one (71) years.

- 2. Of the confirmed cases are (3) learners from different schools. One (1) case have received one (1) dose of the COVID-19 vaccine and eight (8) cases are fully vaccinated. Khomas recorded 87% of the cases.
- 3. We have recorded five (5) new recoveries; two (2) from Erongo region and one (1) each from Omusati, Ohangwena and Otjozondjupa region.
- 4. The number of active cases is one hundred and sixty-three (163). Twelve (12) are hospitalized, of which one (1) is in Intensive Care Unit (ICU). None of the hospitalized including ICU cases is vaccinated.

6. By 29 November 2021, a total of **369 251** people have received one dose of the COVID-19 vaccine, of which **82 112** have received the Janssen vaccine, administered as one dose, while **228 375** had received two doses. Therefore, **310 487** have completed the vaccination, as depicted on tables 3 and 4 below:

8. **Key message:**

- New cases reported from Khomas region radically increase by 85% compared to those reported yesterday. This give an icreament of 84% nationally. This is a clear indication that we need to change our behaviours if we are to curb further transmission. Let us be reminded that the second wave peaked on the 13 December 2020. Let us guard that this does not happen again this year.
- We continue to monitor the situation with regard to Omicron variant. So far we have not detected its presence in Namibia. This must serve as an insentive to continue to comply with public health measures.
