1. Good afternoon fellow citizens. Today, thirteen (13) confirmed COVID-19 cases were identified from five hundred and thirty-one (531) results received from the testing laboratories. This represents a 2.4% positivity ratio. The gender distribution of the cases is eight (8) males and five (5) females. The age range is from seventeen (17) years to seventy (70) years. The new COVID-19 cases are distributed as follows:
