## UPDATE BY DR. KALUMBI SHANGULA, MINISTER OF HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES ON COVID-19 IN NAMIBIA.

**12 November 2020** 

**WINDHOEK** \*Check against Delivery 1. Good afternoon fellow compatriots. Today we are reporting fifty-three (53) new COVID-19 confirmed cases identified from one thousand two hundred and sixty-eight (1 268) tests performed at the various laboratories. This positive number represent 4.2% positivity ratio. The gender distribution of the cases is thirty (30) males and twenty-three (23) females. The age range is from nine (9) to seventy-eight (78) years. The new COVID-19 cases are distributed as follows:

- 2. Among the fifty-three (53) confirmed cases, seven (7) are from different educational institutions made up of both teachers and learners. Cases are reported sporadically from different areas and different localities.
- 3. Today we are reporting four hundred and forty-nine (449) new recoveries of which four hundred and forty-one (441) are from Khomas Region. This brings the total number of recoveries to 12 188.
